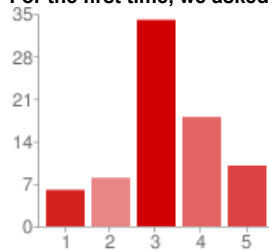

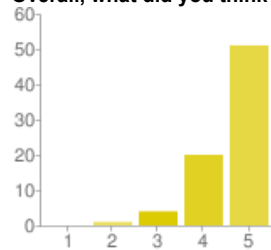
### In your own words, please tell us if there's anything you liked or disliked about the ticketing process in general.

"The Ranch" is our name for Freezer Burn's new home, an real live ranch owned by Mark & Tina Stewart. We'd like to know what you think of this new venue.

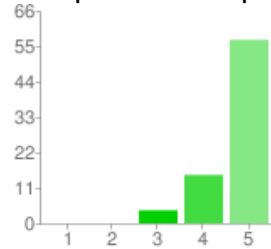

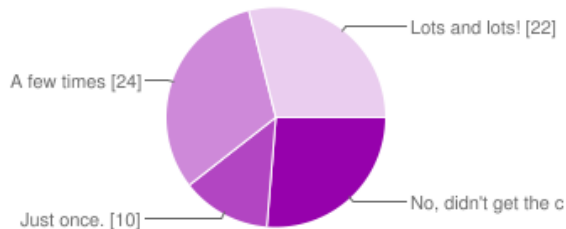
**Do you have any comments about the new venue this year?**

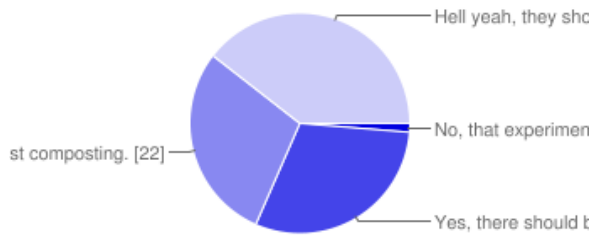
**Did you use the composting toilets this year?**

Hell yeah, they should all be composting toilets, they rocked!	30	39%

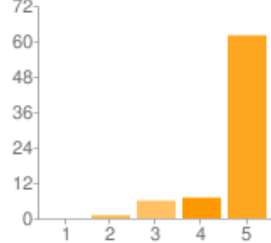


**Any comments about the Humanure project?**
