2024 LNT Report

Noteworthy Items:

- Porto banks were not adequately emptied. Items found included several laminated signs, Air fresheners, cans/bottles, a camp spoon and general debris. Also blue juice from the honey trucks.
- Collection of cans was left on the land.
- Art Project was left on the land (later collected late Monday night after LNT cleaned it up.)
- Several areas where there were white spray marks which look like fire retardant or another type of chemical. After reviewing all areas and notes, we do not believe these were from Freezer Burn attendees.

GREEN

Hugs E for Everyone: Metal Screw



GREEN

Hot Yiff: paint in grass (purple/blue)



YELLOW

Bizarre blvd: Fake Grass. This was in the middle of the boulevard, we do not believe this was from a Freezer Burn participant.



RED

420 Snack Shack: Wig hair, ramen noodles, orange & green painted styrofoam, joint butts, ear plugs & vomit.



GREEN

Camp Awkward: small amount of blue paint flecks



RED

LBC: large amount of wood chips, bbq/smoker style





YELLOW

Fortuna's Grove: black hairpin, disintegrated blue tarp (not from Freezer Burn, recorded prior to set up)



YELLOW

SMOL camp: metal o-rings, sequins, string/thread & metal twist tie





Free Camping: metal candy cane stake, Toilet paper mess, Black hook & pile of safety pins, broken light/glass, food debris, vomit & feces found in the Parking area.



DOWNSTAIRS DETAILS:

1 Canvas buckle and Rope left from art installation on 2 trees. One near top and one further down on west side of Sparkle pony

3. Burnt pages were found near the temple in large amounts but were also found throughout both burnareas. Pictures weren't taken

4. What appears to be fire retardant between temple and man burn. There were 3 piles of it, it was dried when we found it



5. There were tent pegs found at the site of Avondale's Edge. We only photographed one of them but there were several



6. The Fireworks area across the stream was awful. There were 6 of us and it took a good 10-15 minutes for us to get it cleaned up. It was mostly casings strewn well west of the launch area. We did not get photos unfortunately

7. There were several holes left from both the art installation and the sound camp. The space was cleaned very well otherwise. They may need a reminder that LNT means filling in the holes they made as well.
